

**Request for Bids for Electric Generation Service for the Participating Members
of the New Jersey Sustainable Energy Joint Meeting**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New Jersey Sustainable Energy Joint Meeting (“NJSEM”) is requesting bids from electric power suppliers duly licensed by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities for electric generation service for approximately 165 participating local government entities. The NJSEM has issued a Request for Bids (“RFB”) in accordance with the “Electric Discount and Energy Competition Act,” P.L. 1999, c. 23, (“EDECA”); “Local Public Contracts Law,” (N.J.S.A 40A:11-1 *et seq.*); the Local Unit Electronic Procurement Act P.L. 2018, c.156; and all applicable regulations and standards promulgated thereunder (hereafter referred to collectively as “the Applicable Law”).

Interested suppliers will have the opportunity to supply electric generation service to as many as an estimated 4,900 participating electric accounts located within the service territories of Public Service Electric and Gas, Jersey Central Power and Light, Atlantic City Electric and Rockland Electric.

Interested suppliers must submit a completed Notice of Intent to Bid to NJSEM’s registered energy agent either via email at njsem@gelassociates.com or through its electronic bid platform at: <https://www.publicbiddingsystem.com/> no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 5, 2024. Optional questions will be accepted by NJSEM until 5:00 p.m. on September 5, 2024. Responses to supplier questions and any addendum to the RFB will be distributed to suppliers on the Bid Distribution List by no later than close of business on September 16, 2024. Required Qualification Documents must be submitted electronically by no later than 5:00 p.m. on September 9, 2024. Bids will be accepted electronically by the NJSEM’s registered energy agent via its electronic bid platform at: <https://www.publicbiddingsystem.com/> on September 25, 2024, with a bid submission deadline of 11:30 a.m. on that date.
